What We Do

Through organized volunteers, partners and sponsors, Hearts & Hammers provides exterior painting and related repairs to restore the character of the home, the surrounding neighborhood, and to improve the home's safety and security. Program Day work may include: Exterior Painting, Caulking/Weather-Stripping, Repair or Partial Replacement Damaged Siding, Fascia, or Trim, Accessibility Ramp/Railings, Stair/Walkway Repair, Window/Door Repair, Gutter Repair, Deck/Porch Repair, and Landscape Renewal. Volunteers do not provide interior home repair, major electrical, or plumbing services.

1. You currently live in and own a single-family residence in the Twin Cities metro area and intend to live in this home for at least the next two years.
2. You must be at least 60 years old, a Disabled Individual, a Veteran of the United States Armed Forces, or their Surviving Spouse
